• THREAD EMBROIDERY •

Thread embroidery is a technique of stitching designs onto fabric using thread, either by hand or machine. It creates images, patterns, or logos using colored threads without additional decorations like sequins or beads.



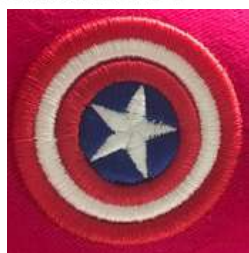
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• 3D EMBROIDERY •

3D embroidery is a technique that creates raised, dimensional designs on fabric, giving patterns a bold and sculpted appearance.



PATCH EMBROIDERY

Patch embroidery is a technique where embroidered designs are created on fabric pieces (patches) that can be sewn or ironed onto clothing and accessories for decoration or personalization.



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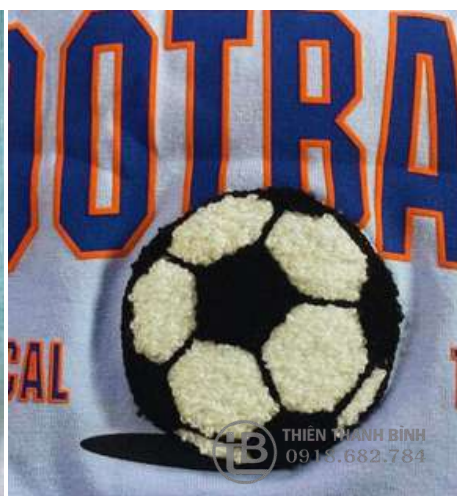
• CHENILLE EMBROIDERY •

Chenille embroidery is a technique that creates soft, fuzzy, and textured designs on fabric using looped or cut yarns, giving a raised and velvety effect.



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• LOGO EMBROIDERY •

It refers to the logo of a well-known brand that is stitched directly onto a product (clothing, hats, backpacks, bags, etc.). This type of finish uses machine embroidery or hand embroidery to create the logo with thread instead of printing or heat-pressing.



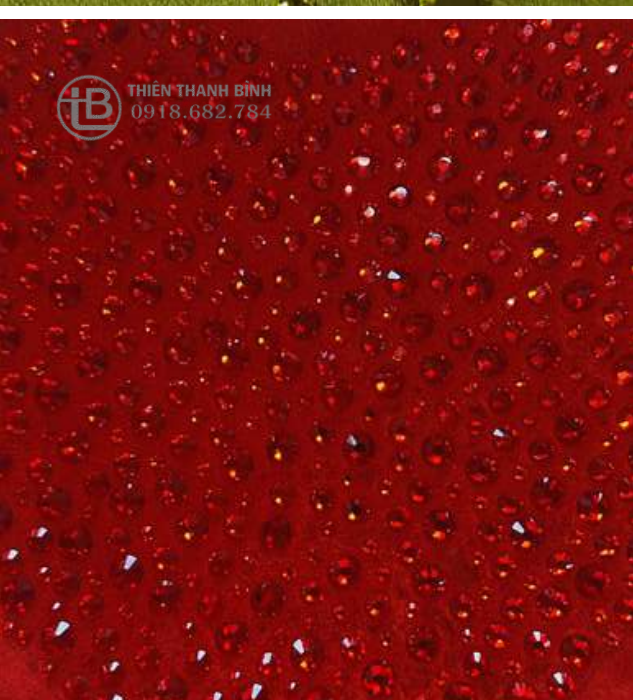
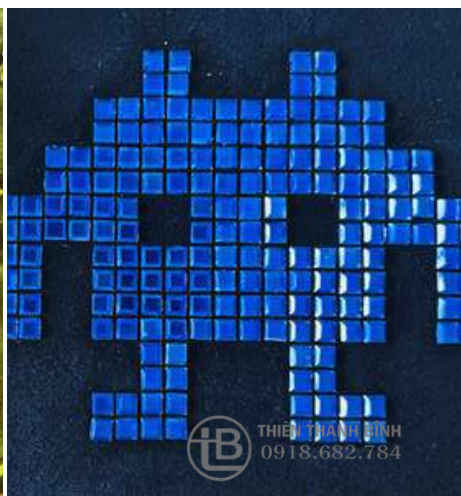
• CHAINSTITCH EMBROIDERY •

Chainstitch embroidery is an embroidery technique that forms interlinked looped stitches, creating a chain-like line on the surface of the fabric.



HOTFIX FLATBACK

A hotfix is a type of decorative rhinestone or embellishment that has a heat-activated adhesive on the back, allowing it to be attached to fabric using heat (such as a heat press or household iron).



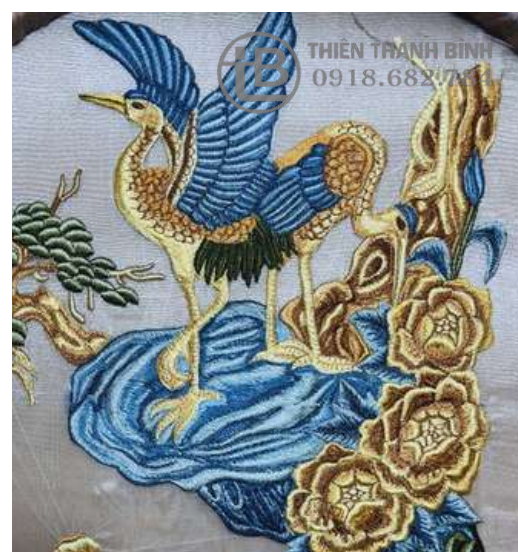
• SEQUIN EMBROIDERY •

Sequin embroidery is a technique that attaches shiny sequins to fabric to create a bright, decorative effect.



• IMITATING HAND EMBROIDERY •

Imitating Hand Embroidery is a machine embroidery technique designed to mimic the look and feel of hand stitching, combining the natural, soft appearance of handwork with the speed and consistency of machine production



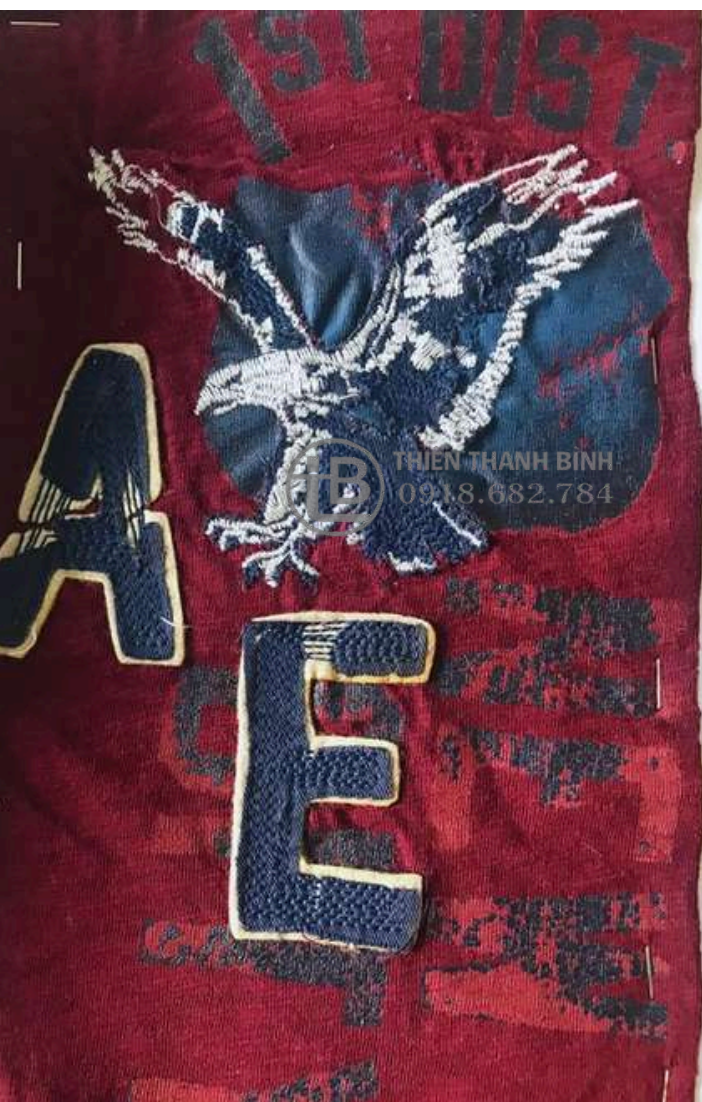
• SPECIAL EMBROIDERY •

Special embroidery refers to embroidery techniques that go beyond basic stitching, using unique methods, materials, or effects to create striking decorative highlights on a product.



• APPLIQUE EMBROIDERY •

Applique embroidery is a technique where pieces of fabric are sewn onto a base material to create decorative designs with added texture and contrast.



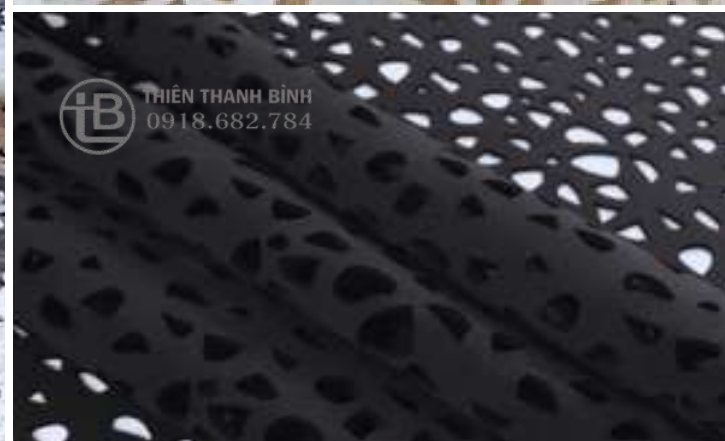
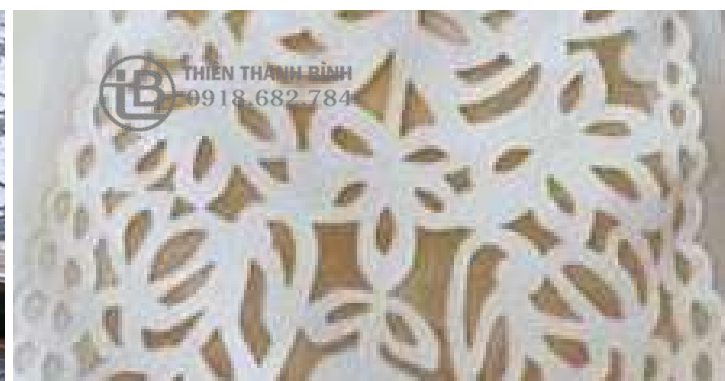
• CUTWORK EMBROIDERY •

Cutwork embroidery is a decorative technique where portions of the fabric are cut away and the edges are stitched to create open, lace-like patterns.



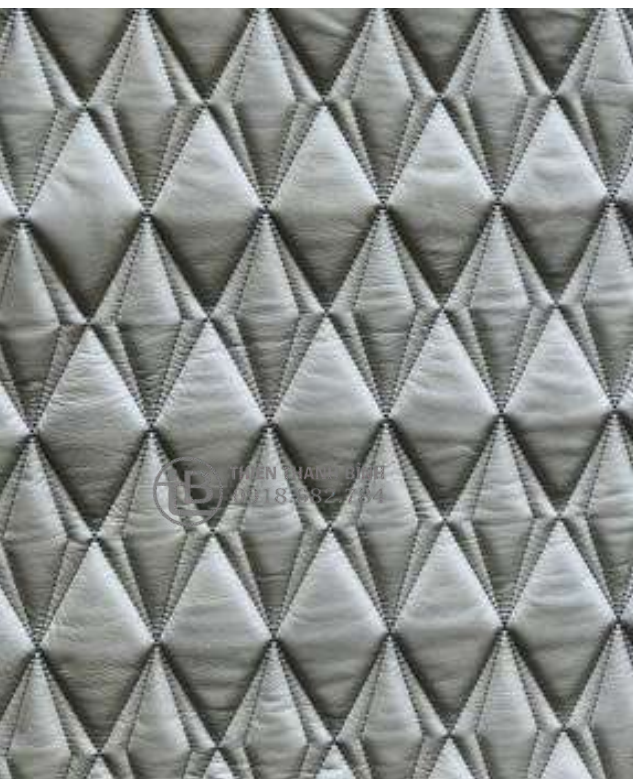
LAZER CUTTING

Laser cutting on fabric uses a laser beam (usually CO₂) to cut, engrave, or shape fabric into any desired design—such as logos, decorative patterns, embroidered pieces, fabric flowers, and custom shapes.



• QUILTED EMBROIDERY •

Quilted Embroidery is a technique that combines embroidery and quilting to create soft, elegant, 3D textured patterns on fabric. It is widely used in fashion, accessories, and premium handcrafted products.



• BEADING EMBROIDERY •

Beading embroidery is the art of decorating fabric by sewing beads onto it, adding texture, sparkle, and intricate patterns.



HAND EMBROIDERY

Hand embroidery is the art of decorating fabric using needle and thread by hand, allowing for intricate designs and a personal, handcrafted touch.



• MERROW EMBROIDERY •

Merrow embroidery is a technique that creates a thick, rounded border on the edge of an embroidered patch using a Merrow machine.





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
